- RIDING OVER OPEN SPACES OR ALONG ANCIENT BRIDLEWAYS.

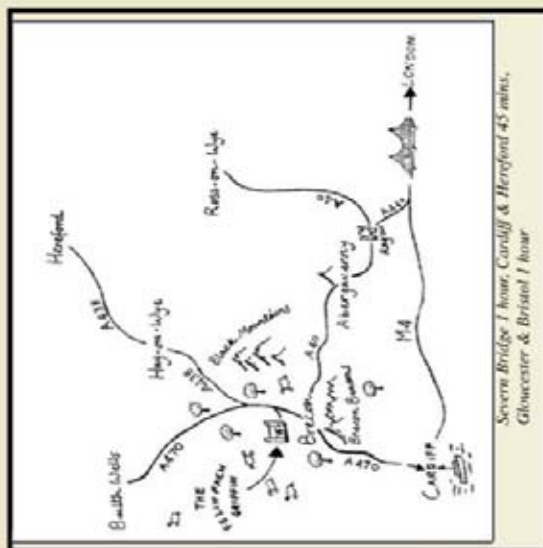
